# A NEW SCHOOL

This is the headline by means of which the BLOC asked some time ago for the building of a new school. And now, when it is governing our Town Council and holds posts involving responsibility, it seems that its “demand” (already rejected) was only a vote-catching measure. That is why Busot will not have a new school in the next four years due to the ineptitude of the current government team from the BLOC.

Considering circumstances up to date and taking into account that they aren’t able and don’t know how; they want to use THE PLAN PROPOSED BY THE PARTIDO POPULAR to the Conselleria de Educación in the year 2001, in which the extension of the school with two more new classrooms was suggested.

Today, the proposal made by the PP and criticized by the BLOC years ago is considered by them as a good idea and enough for our school, since it is now when they have the chance of showing how good they are, offering what they promised and so much criticized, as you say in the Canal Obert of the year 2003, in which you assure that Busot already needed a new school four years ago, so?:

**.- why do you think now that the extension of the school approved by the Partido Popular is a good idea?,**

**.- aren’t you able to build a new school? What do you want now, to receive the recognition for the building of the new two classrooms?**

Your voters will feel really disappointed, above all those parents you have terribly fooled with your lies, because they must know that in order to receive the recognition for the extension of the two new classrooms, you have tabled a motion in a plenary meeting in which you ask the consellería to hurry to build them, and as far as we know, they are still laughing at the content of this motion.

Of course, it is sad and terrible for the Partido Popular and our town to see that the only step they have been able to take is this ridiculous motion, which has been developed once more only as a vote-catching measure, lying again above all regarding the only thing they are interested in: “VOTES”.

They lie so blatantly that they even dare say that the Partido Popular have voted against this ridiculous motion, when the Partido Popular is and has been the only party that has really done something in favour of our school. We remind you some of them:

**.- Who made the school bus possible?  
You, the Bloc?**

# 2004 BUDGET

The BLOC NACIONALISTA VALENCIÀ plays again a leading role in one of its well-known performances; it has a note of humour, quite a lot of science fiction and is mainly based on the lack of faculties and training of the members of the government team, which tries to deceive people from Busot by means of lies and imaginary interventions.

In the Canal Obert of January, they exactly say:

*“The budget means, regarding the year 2003, an increase of the 30.46 % ... there will be a loan of 250.000 euros, so the financial cost will be a 7 %. We must emphasized the fact that up to date it was a 6% due to the loans to the value of 255.000 euros that were asked for by the previous municipal council for the Casa de cultura and other investments...”*

The Partido Popular answers to this with a question, which we hope they can answer, because at least until the present day 2 plus 2 is 4:

**If 50 mill/ptas were owed before, and now 100 mill/ptas are owed... why do they say that the debt changes from the 6 % to the 7 %? Do they think we are stupid? Do they lie again?**

“The increase of the budget, members from the BLOC (we clarify it for you) is mainly caused by two factors:

**1<sup>ST</sup>.- VERY IMPORTANT: You have increased all the existing taxes and fees in more than a 30.46 %, rubbish, building works, permits, water, swimming pool, etc, etc...**

**2<sup>nd</sup>.- REALLY IMPORTANT: Your salaries (stated below) have been increased three times over the salaries of the previous government team, with a total amount of about 18,000,000 Ptas. or 110,000 Euros. It is the only reason why the budget has been increased in a 30.46 %.**

Concerning the existing loans, we can assure you that they were used to finance part of the following investments: THE CASA DE CULTURA (now they boast about it), THE NEW MULTIPURPOSE GYMNASIUM, THE NEW CHANGING ROOMS, THE GRANDSTAND AND THE NEW FIVE-A-SIDE FOOTBALL PITCH (that was made by the Partido Popular, although you are going to inaugurate it), THE NEW RESERVOIR, THE BUY OF THE CIVIL GUARD STATION...(etc, etc...)

# A lot of fines but little security

It is surprising that, only in one year of government by the BLOC, more fines have been dealt with than in the whole previous legislature (4 years) in which the Partido Popular governed. Perhaps this fact would not be so surprising if crime weren't increasing alarmingly in our town, above all in housing estates, which have already sent several letters to the Mayor explaining their complaints. In these letters we can find the signatures of hundreds of residents in the "Hoya de los Patos" and "Llano Pastores".

The Partido Popular of Busot wants you to know that the new two police officers that joined the Local Police in the middle of September were budgeted by **the previous government team ( the PP)** to meet the needs of our town in the year 2003, but on condition that these new positions were as "permanent public officers", since only that will allow a wider and more secure 24-hour service.

We don't know the reason why the BLOC, which ought to have carried out the announcement for these two positions during the month of June 2003, waits until September (after the summer) and announces them as "**temporary employees**", **taking into account that law prohibits nocturnality for these kind of employees.** So, we haven't made any progress.

However, in the previous plenary meeting in April, **the Partido Popular tabled a motion to contract two new posts of Local Police officers as permanent public officer**, in order to have the 24-hour security service we deserve. But once more, the BLOC votes against and so we are afraid that unfortunately, and due to the lack of training of the government team, we will have to contract a private security service or another preventive system which can guarantee us the peace we deserve and pay for.

# **Do you want a clean town?**

## **Pay for it!!!**

At this moment in time, we can see that the BLOC NACIONALISTA have not been able to solve the problem of cleaning and rubbish collection that they so much denounced in the past. Well, we assure you that for them it is a serious problem that it seems they can't face up. We have received a lot of complaints from residents about the current management of the cleaning service, but the funniest thing about it is that the services councillor, Mr. Jaime Mestre, the instigator and forerunner of previous demonstrations (photo) against the local PP denouncing how the housing estates have been allowed to fall into neglect, now says that everything is in this condition because:

After a year of government by the BLOC, we can state with absolute certainty that **BUSOT IS WORSE THAN NEVER BEFORE**. It can be proved by asking the residents both of the housing estates and of the urban area.

Well, "as we require more cleaning and better services", then, **AN INCREASE IN TAXES!!!!!!!**, so that the tax on the collection and cleaning of goods and chattels changes from 30 Euros to 50 Euros. Now, and due to the pressure exerted by residents, a company has been contracted to clean the streets with a road sweeper, and this costs about 50,000 Euros a year.

**IT IS THE RESIDENTS' FAULT, THEY ARE NOT AWARE AND THEIR AWARENESS MUST BE INCREASED. HA, HA!!!**

The Partido Popular thinks this is great (we are paying for it), but in two consecutive plenary meetings, "we have suggested to buy this road sweeper" since the cost of buying it is about 50,000 Euros, so that in a year and a half it would belong to the Town Council and increase our resources, and also this would involve two new jobs in our town to which everyone could accede.

The contract with this company is for a period of seven years, extendable for 10 years, but we think it is very curious that the company which has been contracted is owned by a councillor from the Bloc of Pinoso, who spends more time at our town council than some of the councillors from the BLOC. In the last plenary meeting, the members from the Partido Popular warned them of a possible irregularity, which of course will be investigated.

# HEADLINES AND MORE IMPORTANT NEWS OF THE 1<sup>ST</sup> BULLETIN

## **THE MAYOR AND HIS COUNCILLORS ARE LINING THEIR OWN POCKETS.**

The salaries that the members of the Bloc pay themselves make the economy of BUSOT shake. In the following four years, the members of the government team of the BLOC will cost us more than 80 million pesetas.

## **THE BLOC INCREASES TAXES**

After eight years of government of the PARTIDO POPULAR without increasing taxes, the BLOC has already increased the first taxes only in three months, starting with water, rubbish, building permits, ect, etc... and later, the BLOC will increase the rest of taxes in order to maintain the current budget. Moreover, it creates new local taxes to collect them in public offices of the Town Council.

### **INCREASE IN THE TAX ON CONSTRUCTIONS, BUILDING WORKS, ALTERATIONS, DEMOLITIONS.**

The increase in this tax means an increase of the 0.2 %, changing from the 2.4 % to the 2.6 % of the total cost of the building work to be carried out.

### **INCREASE IN THE TAXES ON BUILDING PERMITS AND OTHER URBAN DEVELOPMENT ACTIONS**

It is an increase of the 40 %, something really incredible, changing to:

Constructions and installations, Demolitions and land movements,  
From the 1 % to the 1.4 % of the estimate cost.

### **INCREASE IN THE TAX ON RUBBISH COLLECTION**

Regarding this increase, figures speak for themselves and, once more, the Solomonic solution they use to solve the problems has aroused our indignation. According to people from the Bloc, they are going to improve the services, but residents in Busot wonder: why are you earning these big salaries if we, the citizens, are going to pay the improvement?

**Houses ..... before 33 euros, now 50 euros.**  
**Shops and other establishments..... before 48 euros, now 72 euros.**

# OUR TOWN SHOULD KNOW ...
